


VOLCANO EGGS

VOLCANO EGGS

Volcano Eggs are a fun and exciting way to teach kids about chemical reactions and the power of science. Watch as your kids' eyes light up with amazement as they discover the hidden toy inside each fizzing egg.



WHAT YOU'LL NEED

- Small bowls or ramekins
- Food Coloring
- Water - in a bowl
- Spoon
- Eye dropper or pipette (optional)
- 1/2 Cup Measuring Cup
- 1 1/2 Cups - Baking Soda
- 3/4 Cup White Vinegar - in a bowl
- Small plastic toys, letters, or numbers
- Tray or Dish (With sides)

SUPER SKILLS

Tactile sensory: Kids can engage this skill when they experience a sensory stimulus through touch from their hands and on their skin. This is one of our 5 senses, the development of which is pivotal to exploring and making sense of the world around us.

In this craft, the children are invited to experience the feeling of the fizzy reaction that occurs when they add the vinegar. This and using the eye dropper or spoon can develop their fine motor skills, hand-eye coordination, and overall sensory awareness.

Directions

1.



Add 2-6 drops of Food Color of each color into a separate bowl or Ramekin.

2.



Pour 2 Tablespoons of water into each bowl.

3.



Add 1/2 Cup of Baking Soda to each Bowl.

4.



Mix one color at a time. (Repeat steps 4-6 for each color. If too dry, add water. If too wet, add baking soda 1 tablespoon at a time.)

5.



Squish half of one color into your palm.
Add a plastic toy for a fun surprise later!

6.



Add other half of dough to shape an egg.
*If crumbly, just mound it onto your dish and get ready for a fizzy reaction!

7.




Pour about 1/2 Cup of vinegar into a clean bowl.
Using an eye dropper, or spoon, add vinegar on top of the eggs.

8.



Uncover your hidden surprises!
Mix the colors with your hands or spoon. What new colors can you create?

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
